

Washing PUL Fabric

Care:

- Machine wash warm or hot (212 degrees F/100 degrees C or less)
- Dry low
- Do not iron
- Do not dry clean
- No bleach, vinegar, or oxy-type products

Bleach, vinegar, and Oxy-clean products are harsh and over time can damage your PUL. Please use regular laundry detergent only.

Eco-PUL™ can withstand plenty of use and the repeated hot washing necessary for reusable items.

PUL should not be dried on high heat in a dryer, very high air heat can cause PUL to wear prematurely, warp or melt. We recommend drying on low.
